RE: East Park Hike & Bike Trail Phase II (PID #112585)

Dear Neighbor,

We are writing this letter in follow-up to the public involvement that has occurred for the proposed construction project titled "East Park Hike & Bike Trail Phase II". A virtual public open house was held on the project website (www.millcreekmetroparks.com/east-park) from September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021 through October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021 – public comments for this phase of the project were accepted during this timeframe.

In total, seven (7) comments were received from five (5) different sources during the design phase of this project. A summary of these comments, as well as a response to each, is included with this letter. A copy of the Public Comments Response Summary document is also available on the project website (www.millcreekmetroparks.com/east-park) or by going to http://www.transportation.ohio.gov and searching the project using the project identification number 112585.

The selected alternative for the project is the build alternative, the alignment was selected based upon existing site conditions, topography, and minimizing potential environmental impacts. The project will ultimately improve safety and connectivity for pedestrian and bicyclist traffic through the East Park Corridor, and the MetroParks as a whole. The East Park Hike & Bike Trail Phase II construction will not require any property acquisition.

The next phase of the project will include the development of detailed engineering plans – the project is expected to go out for bid in the early spring of 2022, with construction to follow in the summer of 2022.


