The mission of Mill Creek MetroParks is to provide park, recreational, educational and open space facilities of regional significance.





TERMINOLOGY


PUBLIC PROGRAM:

Programs planned on a wide variety of topics for general or specific audiences. Available to all visitors who have an interest in attending. These programs are placed on our MCMP website.

SCHOOL PROGRAM: Programs specifically planned and offered to students in consultation with their teachers.

SCHOOL GROUPS: Include public, private, charter,

preschool, and non-school groups (Scouts, homeschool, afterschool, and other youth groups).





ODE TERMINOLOGY

- CORRELATION WITH STATE STANDARDS:
 Process of identifying existing connections or relationships between each program element and the statements of required knowledge or skills in the Ohio Learning Standards.
- ALIGNMENT WITH STATE STANDARDS: Process of making adjustments to programs so that program elements or activities correlate in the best way possible changing, moving, eliminating, developing activities or even whole programs.
- OHIO'S LEARNING STANDARDS: "Learning standards explain the knowledge and skills Ohio students in pre-kindergarten through grade 12 need to have." "Ohio's Learning Standards emphasize skills like critical thinking and problem solving qualities most sought by today's employers. By teaching our students to apply these skills to what they are learning in school, we can make sure they are on track to graduate from high school and enjoy success in college, careers and life."

- Evaluation to determine if objective has been met can be Formative (ongoing) or Summative (conclusion).




