A white sand pink trumpet daffodil with a very broad and very showy cup; a vigorous and strong grower; extra large flowers; 14"-18"; blooms in early-mid spring. 1 W-YPP

### **CEYLON**









Buttercup yellow petals with a red/ orange cup; longest lasting, upward facing blossoms and a terrific perennial; classic 1943; 14"-16"; blooms in earlymid spring. 2 Y-O

# **FALCONET**











3-5 dazzling bright gold and rich orange flowers with an alluring musky sweet perfume; a must for beds, borders and containers; forces nicely; American bred; 12"-14"; blooms early-mid spring. 8 Y-R

## **GOLDEN ECHO**







Long, golden, yellow cup melts down on its creamy white petals; a strong grower; long-lasting and very fragrant; 12"-16"; blooms mid spring. 7 WWY-Y

#### **JETFIRE**







Lovey, small but prolific flower with very reflexed yellow petals and a bright red/orange cup; great form and substance; terrific for the garden; especially good for early forcing; American bred; Classic 1966; 12"-14"; blooms early-mid spring. 6 Y-O

### **MOUNT HOOD**









An old favorite that opens with a bit of yellow in the trumpet but matures to pure white; often performs better in cooler climates; Historic 1938; 15"-17"; blooms mid-spring. 1 W-W

#### **PINK CHARM**









An elegant flower with pure white petals and vivid, pink banded cup; sometimes with two flowers per stem; great naturalizer and very adaptable; 14"-16"; blooms mid-spring. 2 W-WWP

### **PROFESSOR EINSTEIN**









Very large-cupped, eye-catching flower with white petals and a reddish-orange cup; strong grower; 16"-18"; fragrant; blooms mid-spring. 2 W-R

#### SIR WINSTON CHURCHILL







3-5 silver dollar sized creamy white flowers with orange flecks; fresh and sweet scent; perennial habits; superb garden daffodil; 15"-17"; blooms late-mid spring. 4 W-O

#### ÊTE À TÊTE











Buttercup yellow petals with a slightly darker cup; usually two flowers per stem; great for forcing; 5"-6"; 1949; blooms early spring. 12 Y-Y

#### W.P. MILNER





Heirloom, creamy white petals and pale yellow trumpet; twisty petals and nodding heads; Historic 1869; 5"-6"; blooms early-mid spring. 1 W-W
