(Yarian rounded their total amount bid on several items.) Yarian's corrected grand total amount

bid was reduced by \$2.77, but this amount did not affect the order of bids.

- 3. The low bidder at bid opening and after tabulation is Joe Lofaro Concrete.
- 4. Lofaro Concrete's bid was complete and included all the required documentation.
- 5. Lofaro Concrete is experienced in the type of work required on this project and is currently

prequalified with ODOT in 38 separate work classifications.

## RECOMMENDATION:

1. It is recommended that Joe Lofaro Concrete be awarded the contract for the project named "2010 Drive Improvements  $\theta$  West Golf Drive" at the grand total amount bid of \$65,058.50
