Foust Construction's bid was within the 10% bid cap. No mathematical errors were found in either of the bids. The low bidder at bid opening and after tabulation is Foust Construction, Inc. All required bonds, documents, forms and attachments were included with Foust's bid. Foust Construction, Inc. is experienced in the type of work required. Foust is prequalified with ODOT is sixteen separate work type classifications. Foust satisfactorily completed the Old Mill Drive Improvement project for the MetroParks in 2005. One "Add Alternate†item of construction was included in the contract documents, for timber railing adjusted to grade. The estimate for this item totaled \$4,260, and

All required bonds, documents, forms and attachments were included with Karvo Paving's bid. Karvo Paving is experienced in the type of work required. Fifteen pages of project experience and references were included with Karvo Paving's bid. Karvo Paving is prequalified with ODOT in twenty-two (22) separate work type classifications. Karvo Paving has not worked on any recent MetroParks projects.
