- D.D. and Velma Davis Education & Visitor Center** Art gallery, café, history museum, gift shop, horticulture library. Meeting and banquet rooms. Educational classes.
- Arseny Melnick Observation Tower** View Lake Glacier and the Gardens
- Beeghly Garden** Cherry trees, potted plants and The Kneeling Girl fountain
- Watson White Garden** White flowering plants
- DeYor Concourse** Seasonal displays of bulbs and annuals
- Shade Garden** Plants which thrive in low light, natural and cultivated shade areas
- Seasonal Celebration Plaza** Sommer Fountain with benches for garden viewing in all directions
- Perennial Garden** Colorful perennials, bulbs and shrubs
- South Terrace and Kidston Pavilion** A unique setting for weddings and events. View of Lake Glacier is a favorite for photos.
- Modern Rose Garden** Yew and boxwood hedges. Over 1,300 modern roses, hybrid tea, floribunda and grandiflora bloom between June & October.
- Christina's Garden Labyrinth** Experience the beauty of plants on a personal level
- English and Miniature Roses** Plantings in raised beds outlined by annuals
- Herb and Fragrance Garden** Spicy aroma of herbs and sweet scents in the raised bed
- Gazebo** A popular wedding venue surrounded by beds of old-fashioned roses, daylilies, iris and peonies
- Narcissus, Rhododendron and Woody Plant Collections** Daffodils, rhododendrons, azaleas, viburnums and native shrubs with attractive foliage, flowers and berries
- Outdoor Gallery** Exhibit area for art in a natural setting
- Ohio Woodland Garden** Native Ohio trees, shrubs and shade wildflowers
- Quarry Garden** Plants and a trail remain after harvesting stone over 100 years ago
- The Gathering** Stones from the area create seating for discussions and educational opportunities
- Blue Garden** Blue-leaved hostas, blue-flowering annuals, perennials and bulbs
- Hillside Garden** Unusual conifers, gravel stairs
- North Terrace** An urban view of the city of Youngstown. Prominent structures Youngstown State University's Beeghly Stadium and Stambaugh Auditorium and St. Elizabeth's Hospital
- Heather Garden** Winter-blooming heaths and summer-blooming heathers
- Trial Garden** Newest varieties of flowering annuals and vegetables
- Beech Collection** Varieties include European beech and the stately American
- Great Lawn** A gently sloping hill to complement the surrounding trees and colorful beds
- Seasonal Display Beds** Colorful bulbs in spring and vibrant annuals summer - mid-October
- Long Mall** A lush architectural feature lined with blooms from spring through fall
- Dahlia Garden** Beautiful blooms of all sizes & colors
- Family Garden** Whimsical educational planting experiences for the young and young at heart. A showcase for honeybee hives.
- Parking Lot Beds and Geothermal Fields** Low maintenance and drought resistant plantings. A geothermal field with 42 wells under the pavement that naturally heats and cools the Davis Center.
- Horticulture Service Area** Production and grounds operations
