Process

- Application/Background Check
- Volunteer approved or not approved notification

Communication

- o Volunteer needs communicated by staff
- o Volunteer opportunities sent to volunteers via email beginning of each month
 - Communicated to ALL park volunteers
 - Includes dates needed, shifts, duties, attire, how to sign up, etc.

Management

- Raisor's Edge Software
 - Volunteer Module managing and reporting capabilities, linking donors & volunteers

Recognition

- Volunteer Appreciation Picnic (20+ hours from July 1 June 30)
 202 volunteers invited in 2017
- Volunteer t-shirt (10+ hours per calendar year)
 - 185 volunteers qualified in 2017
- Name Badge multiple volunteer participation

- January 1, 2018 March 31, 2018: added 22 regular volunteers (almost 4x the amount compared to this time last year!)
