


2019 Capital Improvements





 - 1 Village



- 225,667 square feet of structures
- 3 large lakes/dams





2019 Capital Improvements

Drive Improvements

- \$250,000 Budgeted
- Old Mill Drive & East Park Drive
 - Old Mill Dr. -- From Kiwatha Rd. to Canfield Rd.
 - East Park Dr. -- From Canfield Rd. to Valley Dr.
 - Reconstruction of Canfield Rd. intersection
 - Drainage structure & pipe replacement
 - Asphalt paving and pavement markings

Annual Preventive Maintenance

- Asphalt lane paving on various drives
- Reapplication of pavement markings
- Crack filling
- Aggregate shoulders







2019 Capital Improvements

Parking Lot Improvements

- \$150,000 Budgeted
- MetroParks Farm
 - Existing asphalt paved portion of parking lot
 - Installation of underdrains
 - Improve traffic circulation
 - Construction of landscape islands
 - Pavement planing, asphalt overlay & pavement markings

Annual Preventive Maintenance

 Crack filling, asphalt sealing & pavement markings



2019 Capital Improvements

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Trail Improvements

- \$150,000 Budgeted
- MetroParks Bikeway
 - Asphalt repair and resurfacing
 - Improve sight distance at S. Turner Rd. crossing
- Ford Nature Center Hiking Trails
 - General improvements to the hiking trails directly adjacent to the FNC
- Hitchcock Woods Hiking Trail
 - Construction of bridges
- East Golf Hike & Bike Trail
 - Improvement of entrances from neighborhood

Signage Improvements

- \$25,000 Budgeted
- Facility
 - MetroParks Farm
 - Chestnut Hill Pavilion
 - Mill Creek Preserve
- Mill Creek Park Road Names
- Mill Creek Park Wayfinding








2019 Capital Improvements

Pavilion Improvements

- \$25,000 Budgeted
- Old Log Cabin
 - Replacement of wood shake shingle roofing
 - Stone masonry repairs on chimney
 - Electrical/lighting upgrades
 - Kitchen renovations, including counters, cabinets, sink, faucet, appliances, painting











Comfort Station Improvements

- \$50,000 Budgeted
- Wick Recreation Area Ballfields
 - Demolition of two (2) existing comfort stations
 - Construction of new vault-type comfort station







2019 Capital Improvements



Bridge Improvements

- \$230,000 Budgeted
- Dividing Sycamore Bridge
 - Located in Mill Creek Park on Bears Den Drive, directly east of West Park Drive
 - Substantially funded at \$164,000 through a FHWA Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant
 - Stabilization of a stone retaining wall, erosion control in Bear Creek, and cleaning & repointing of sandstone walls, railings and arch
- Slippery Rock Bridge
 - Located in Mill Creek Park on West Glacier Drive, at the southerly end of Lake Glacier
 - Repair of sandstone facing on pier







2019 Capital Improvements

Mill Creek Golf Course

- \$300,000 Budgeted
- Greens Drainage
 - Installation of drainage for approximately twenty-nine (29) greens
- Outdoor Learning Center
 - Construction of new greens and bunkers for a practice chipping, pitching and putting area
 - Located between the Field House and the Practice Range









2019 Capital Improvements

MetroParks Farm Improvements

- \$25,000 Budgeted
- Disc Golf Course
 - Construction of a new 18-hole disc golf course
 - Substantially funded at \$16,056 through an ODNR NatureWorks grant





2019 Capital Improvements

Mill Creek Wildlife Sanctuary & Mill Creek Preserve

- \$40,000 Budgeted
- Pond & Dike Improvements
 - Removal of woody vegetation
 - Reconstruction of dikes due to erosion & rodent damage
 - Replacement of drainage control piping & structures
 - Replacement of bird nesting boxes
- Vegetative Invasive Species Control







2019 Capital Improvements

Lantermanc Mill

- \$200,000 Budgeted
- Site Improvements
 - Safety improvement for vehicular, pedestrian and bicycle circulation
 - Partnering with the City of Youngstown for an intersection improvement project at Canfield Road/Old Mill Drive/East Park Drive
 - Construction of official crosswalks with push buttons with an independent crossing phase for the signal
 - Construction of a new pedestrian trail from the Idora parking lot to the Mill





2019 Capital Improvements



Wick Recreation Area

West Elevation

East Elevation

- \$500,000 Budgeted
- Maintenance Facility
 - Construction of a new maintenance facility for Wick Recreation Area, thus removing this function from the Warming House structure
 - Located to the south of the Morley Pavilion parking lot







2019 Capital Improvements

Fellows Riverside Gardens Improvements

- \$115,000 Budgeted
 - \$75k Endowment/\$40k MetroParks

Davis Education & Visitor Center

- Observation Tower waterproofing
- Weller Gallery floor repair
- Sealing of pavement and sandstone surfaces
- Mortar repairs/repointing
- Gutter & fascia repairs
- Replacement of hot water circulator

Site Improvements

- Pavement repairs
- Fencing improvements







2019 Capital Improvements

Ford Nature Center Redevelopment

- \$3,300,000 Budgeted
 - \$3 million building project/\$300k exhibits
- Redevelopment
 - Renovation of estate house structure
 - Renovation of garage structure
 - Site improvements
 - Nature education exhibits
