

Rental Facility Guidelines – Picnic Pavilions

Rain or Shine (no refund due to weather)

Rentable from May through September

9 a.m. – 8:30 p.m. with ½ hour clean-up, must exit facility no later than 9 p.m.

Mill Creek MetroParks provides:

- **Scholl accommodations:**

- Shelter, picnic tables with attached benches to seat 48
- Electricity
- Grill – inside the shelter - Bring your own charcoal

Accommodations in the area *open to the public*:

- Playground, basketball, tennis, ballfields, lawn area
- Spray basin (10 a.m. – 7 p.m. weather permitting)
- Restrooms – outhouse type
- Running water
- Trash bins
- Parking – 70 spaces

- **Bresko accommodations:**

- Shelter, picnic tables with attached benches to seat 24
- Electricity

Accommodations in the area *open to the public*:

- Playground, tennis, ballfields, lawn area, golf, batting cages, volleyball
- Wet Playground (10 a.m. – 7 p.m. weather permitting)
- Grill – bring your own charcoal
- Restrooms – flush toilets nearby
- Trash bins
- Parking – unlimited

Transfers | Changes | Cancellations

- Mill Creek MetroParks is not responsible for inclement weather; customer is responsible for making alternative plans.
- Reservations may be transferred to another date or to another facility up to 5 days in advance of date reserved.
- Your receipt number must be provided to us in order to make a transfer, change, or cancellation.
- An original reservation may be transferred a maximum of two (2) times, after that, it will be treated as a cancellation.
- When cancelling a reservation that has been transferred, the refund schedule is based on the original date reserved, not the transferred date.
- Refunds will be processed within 5 working days after the cancellation is received, according to the cancellation schedule below.
 - Prior to 60 days before reserved date 85% refund
 - 30-60 days before reserved date 50% refund
 - Less than 30 days before reserved date no refund

You are agreeing to, and are responsible for:

- Using the facility between the hours of 9 a.m. – 9 p.m. only
- The conduct of your guests, and making them aware of the *prohibited* items listed below
 - Alcohol, smoking, gambling, disorderly conduct, boisterous or profane language
 - Bounce Houses/Inflatables, large grills, canopies, etc.
 - NO open flames. Candles must be under glass
 - Tacks, nails, confetti, water balloons, chalk, silly string, glitter
 - Music that is played loud enough to disturb or be offensive to other MetroParks visitors
 - Ticket sales or admission fees, sale of food, beverage, article, privilege, service, or subscription
 - Soliciting donations or collections for any purpose
 - Children & teenage groups are not permitted to use a facility without being adequately chaperoned during the entire event.
 - Pets or animals
- Adhering to the maximum attendance limits as listed above
- Leaving the facility, grounds, and parking lot in the condition you found it; tables and benches **must not** be moved.
- Anything brought in to facility **MUST** arrive during the rental time and **MUST** be removed by end of rental time.
- Putting all trash in appropriate bins
- If the facility is not clean, damaged, or anything left behind that has to be removed by the MetroParks will result in renter being billed for such charges incurred.

Agreement

- At the time of payment, you are agreeing to be bound by these guidelines, and by the General Rules and Regulations of Mill Creek MetroParks which can be found at <https://www.millcreekmetroparks.org/contact/about/park-rules-regulations/>
- Failure to abide by these rules and regulations, and failure to use MetroParks' facilities in a responsible manner could cause your permit to be revoked with forfeiture of the reservation fee, and the responsible party will be billed.
