MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS OF MILL CREEK METROPARKS HELD TUESDAY, OCTOBER 13, 2020.

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners of Mill Creek MetroParks was held on Tuesday, October 13, 2020. The Meeting was video recorded and broadcasted live via Facebook Live Video.

The Board was presented with the Minutes of the Meeting of September 21, 2020. Commissioner Frey accepted the minutes into the records as written.

Kevin Smith, Finance Director/Treasurer presented the Department Report for Finance and requested that disbursements #83138 - #83297 for a total of \$1,163,681.81 be approved. The statue was first unveiled on October 12, 1920.
